Morell River Management Cooperative

Morell River Management Cooperative (MRMC) has a well-established history in watershed conservation, restoration, and enhancement. The organization has its roots in the Morell and Area Land Use Steering Committee, which successfully created PEI's first Conservation Zone along the Morell River.

The Conservation Zone (Green Belt) protects 60 meters on each side of the river from development of any kind, preserving the wilderness of the Morell River for present and future generations.

On July 20, MRMC celebrated the 50th anniversary of the Green Belt at Rossiter Park with cake and a tree planting ceremony dedicated to the members of the 1975 Steering Committee.

The crew at MRMC continues to work hard to improve fish and wildlife habitats. This year they cleared many kilometers of streams to maintain good water quality and to ensure that native fish can migrate.

A shoreline cleanup along 22 km of St. Peter's Bay was completed in August and 800 trees were planted



along the Morell River. The crew also maintains the trails and facilities at Mooney's Pond for the community to use and enjoy.
